Monthly Board meeting
May 10, 2026

Dan called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM with Dan Hoffman, Bryan Jochimsen, Chad Smith, JoAnn Smith, and Tony Schumacher present. Dan opened the meeting by reciting the pledge. He then had JoAnn read the April meeting minutes.

Chad made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Bryan seconded. Motion carried.

Bills: Bill were reviewed and approved with a motion by Chad. Seconded by Bryan. Motion carried.

Bids: Bids for road materials were opened and reviewed. Bryan made a motion to except the low bid for 38% calcium chloride from Slobodnik of \$1.58 per gallon. Chad seconded. Motion carried.

Chad made a motion to approve the low bid for gravel from the Sperl pit from Melvin Companies of \$10.57 per ton. Bryan seconded the motion carried.

Chad made a motion to approve the low bid for 5/8 blue rock from Slobodnik at \$11.74 per yard. Bryan seconded the motion carried.

Chad made a motion to approve the low bid for 3–5-inch rock from Slobodnik of \$11.97 per yard. Bryan seconded the motion carried.

Dan made a motion to approve the low bid for 5/8 red rock from Bugar of 12.43. Chad seconded the motion carried.

Road Report: Culvert on Elm west of Hemlock was discussed along with one on Swallow.

TDS: Discussed TDS laying fiber line and the need for them to lay their fiber at least 8 ft. deep on the big hill on Gibson. The board discussed the need for the utility pole on the corner of Apple and Gibson moved back this year. Dan will call Mark.

Liquor Licenses: Bryan made a motion to approve liquor license applications from P&E Steakhouse and A&E Tavern along with a cigarette license from A& E and all bartender licenses from both. Chad seconded the motion carried.

CCC: JoAnn reported that all going well. There won't be a Mother's Day buffet this year as the Wolf celebration of life will be Saturday and they expect it to be big, 500 plus.

Zoning: 2 land sales, 1 building permit written.

Chuck Zenner: No report.

Treasurer Report: Tony reported a starting balance of \$360,832.94. Income for the month of \$23,998.57. Expenses \$9,234.34. Leaving a balance of \$375,597.17. Chad made a motion to approve the treasures report. Bryan seconded. Motion carried.
