Section 25.01 PLACING SUBSTANCE ON HIGHWAY

This repeals and recreates Section 25.01 PLACING SUBSTANCE ON HIGHWAY
1/4/2009

AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE.

This Ordinance is adopted under the general authority granted pursuant to §60.10(2)(c), §60.22(1), §81.01, §346.94(5), §346.94(7), §346.95(2), and §346.95(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes; to promote the public safety, health and general welfare of the community, to further the safe and orderly layout of driveways that enter onto roads within the Town.

A. Placing injurious substance on highway. No person shall place or cause to be placed upon a highway any foreign substance which is or may be injurious to any vehicle or part thereof. This includes plowing snow from driveways. The penalty for a violation of this portion of this ordinance shall be \$50 as determined by the Town Board. Each day will be considered a violation. Violator shall be responsible for the cleanup or pay the cost of the cleanup.

B. Spilling loads of waste or foreign matter. The operator of every vehicle transporting waste or foreign matter on the highways of this state shall provide adequate facilities to prevent such waste or foreign matter from spilling on or along the highways. The penalty for a violation of this portion of this ordinance shall be \$50 as determined by the Town Board. Each day will be considered a violation. Violator shall be responsible for the cleanup or pay the cost of the cleanup

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage as provided by law.
