## General regulations For Driveways:

- 1. Include a map indicating the location and dimensions of the desired driveway and highway access locations. A. Include lot lines, access roads and location of parcel.
- 2. Driveways must intersect with Town Roads and highways at right angles.
- 3. Driveway should be located a minimum of 150 feet from the center of a town or highway intersection.
- 4. Driveways shall be placed no closer than 15 feet from the lot line.
- 5. All driveways and parking areas shall be graded in such a manner so that no storm water, silt, gravel, or other outwash is discharged onto the roadway.
- 6. The first 24 feet of the driveway can not exceed a 5% slope at the point where the driveway enters on to a public road.
- 7. An area equal to driveway width and eighteen (18) feet in height shall be cleared for emergency service vehicles.
