RECYCLING MIX #1

Remove Labels

1. Clean milk, juice, and other food containers (**WASH or RINSE, remove all food**)
2. Unbroken glass containers; **NO CERAMIC DISHES OR WINDOW GLASS**
3. Clean plastic containers, (Emblems 1 to 7); **NO OIL OR CHEMICAL CONTAINERS**
4. Tin and aluminum cans; **NO PAINT OR AEROSOL CANS**

RECYCLING MIX #2

1. Clean, corrugated cardboard, (**FLATTENED**)
2. All types of paper, (box, bag, or tie); **NO PAPER PLATES, SOILED NAPKINS, OR WAX PAPER**
3. Newspapers

GARBAGE

35 gallon bag or less: \$3.00

55 gallon bag or less: \$5.00

Clean Sweep (generally first weekend of May)

Taylor County offers residents an opportunity to dispose of unneeded chemical products and appliances safely at either no or low cost

Please dispose of your ag plastics in a landfill. Containers with leftover chemicals can be taken to Clean Sweep.

Old Tire Recycling

Generally held twice in August from 8 AM to Noon at 5 different locations, including Medford and Gilman Highway Departments.

Cost(2019): up to 18" = \$3, 19 to 22"=\$5, 23 to 24"=\$10, over 24" (tractor)=\$20 and oversized (skidder, grader, endloader etc) \$50. No free tires or rims accepted. Prices subject to change.
