

Notice of Pending Application for Wetland Disturbance

The Town of Little Black has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to fill Wetlands. The project is located on Gibson Road in the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4, Section 11, Township 30, Range 01 E, Town of Little Black, Taylor County.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11, and 30.208, Wis. Stats., and ch. NR 150 and NR 103, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36, Wis. Stats., if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will **issue** the permit for the proposed activity.

Comments should include the docket number or applicant name and should relate to whether the project meets the legal standards listed above. Comments must be submitted or postmarked no later than 30 days after the date on which the Department first publishes the notice on our Internet website.

If you would like to request a public informational hearing, the request must be submitted or postmarked within 20 days after the date on which the Department first publishes the notice on our Internet website. A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing. If no hearing is requested, the Department will issue its decision without a hearing. If a hearing is held, comments must be submitted or postmarked no later than 10 days following the hearing date.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
